## The SHRHS Class of 2019

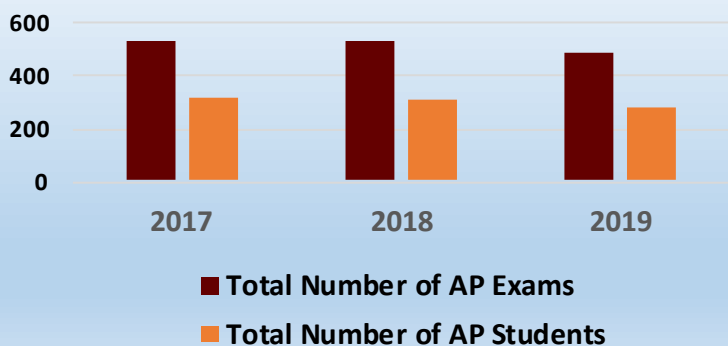

## Project Lead the Way

**Biomedical Science** In these innovative grant-funded courses, students take on real-world challenges and work with the same tools used by professionals in hospitals and labs. Students engage in compelling, hands-on activities and work together to find solutions to problems presented to them in case studies.

**Engineering**—Each PLTW Engineering course engages students in interdisciplinary activities like working with a client to design a home, programming electronic devices or robotic arms, or exploring algae as a biofuel source. These activities not only build knowledge and skills in engineering, but also empower students to develop essential skills such as problem solving, critical and creative thinking, communication, collaboration, and perseverance.



Our Career Pathways program provides information for students and parents in identifying a post-secondary career plan and in selecting an appropriate course of study while in high school. Certificate programs, including Global Awareness Engineering/Stem, Biomedical, Criminal Justice, and Communications, will provide students with effective skills for success in the technologically complex, globally competitive world of the twenty-first century.
